The Board may not take any action or engage in any discussion on matters presented during the public COMMENT period.

The purpose of public comment is to allow the public to address the Board and the Board is interested in hearing from members of the public, stakeholders and interested parties. However, speakers are asked to exercise courtesy and consider the rights of other speakers by adhering to the (3) minute time limit set forth and if possible, refrain from unnecessary repetition of their comments.
